SOCIAL VALUE:

THE BUBBLE & SQUEAK BUS: A COMMUNITY RESOURCE



In partnership with the Costain-Skanska Joint Venture (CSjv), we repurposed a retired 2003 Volvo Plaxton bus into a vibrant community space for the charity organisation Bubble and Squeak. Originally decommissioned for not meeting current emission standards, the bus found a second life as an accessible learning and activity hub for young people through this meaningful joint initiative.

Working closely with CSjv, we fitted the bus with tables, chairs, and a television, transforming it into a **flexible overflow classroom**. Additionally, we fitted the outdoor area with astroturf, customised with designs by students at Old Oak Primary School, with similar turf added to parts of the bus interior to create a unique, green setting.

Now in use at Old Oak Primary School, **near the HS2 route**, the Bubble & Squeak Bus is a welcoming space for children and the local community to **learn**, **play**, **and connect**.

This project exemplifies our commitment to creating lasting social value and providing valuable resources for our communities.
